SUBJECT: Information Request - Potential FFY 2025 Federal Government Shutdown

In preparation for a potential federal government shutdown on October 1, the Office of State Budget and Management (OSBM) is surveying agencies about the potential impact to state operations. As of today, Congress has not enacted any of the 12 appropriation bills required to fund the federal government. Failure to pass any of these bills or a continuing resolution by September 30 will lead the US Office of Management and Budget (OMB) to issue guidance related to a full or partial federal government shutdown. Therefore, all state agencies need to thoroughly review federally funded grant awards and commitments to identify impacted areas and develop strategies to mitigate service and operational disruptions.

We ask all agencies, regardless of whether you receive federal funds, to complete this form. When completing the form, please assume a full federal shutdown will occur October 1. Please complete the form by COB Thursday, September 26, 2024.
