SUBJECT: 2025-27 Biennium Change Budget Instructions

The Office of State Budget and Management (OSBM) is kicking off the 2025-27 biennium change budget process and looks forward to partnering with you. As in prior cycles, agencies should engage internally and with OSBM in a collaborative effort to develop evidence-based budget proposals to carry out your agency's mission and strategic plan over the next biennium. The process will involve agency budget and financial staff, program directors, policy staff, chief information officers, and other members of agency senior leadership.

In contrast to recent years, state revenues have stabilized, and our tax structure will limit growth going forward. Agencies should keep these constraints in mind when developing and submitting requests. With limited resources, we want to invest in delivering critical services and in those programs with the greatest likelihood of success. Programs with strong evidence and/or strong evaluation plans that are clearly linked to strategic plans will be prioritized during the budget development process.

OSBM is sensitive to the many demands on agency time, and we continue to look for ways to streamline the process each year. Significant changes to this year's budget process include:

- 1. Agencies are <u>no longer</u> required to submit an ABC list for operational requests to OSBM. Instead, agencies will submit draft copies of the Justification Documentation Form (JDF) for each of their requests. This year's updated form includes a place for agencies to rank requests.
- 2. Since the WSII now includes fewer questions than were on the WSII-EZ, OSBM has eliminated the WSII-EZ.

Jan. 17 <sup>th</sup>	Final Worksheet-IIIs, Worksheet-IIIs, OC-25s, and Special Provision forms due
Jan. 17 <sup>th</sup>	Submit updated enrollment/population cost data
Feb. 17 <sup>th</sup>	Final Special Provision language due
